

**BYLAWS  
OF THE  
DALLAS PALEONTOLOGICAL SOCIETY**

**ARTICLE I**                      NAME

The Dallas Paleontological Society may herein be referred to as "the Society".

**ARTICLE II**                      PURPOSE

The Bylaws shall be the common laws by which the Society shall function.

**ARTICLE III**                      ESTABLISHMENT OF BYLAWS

The Executive Committee shall have the authority to establish Bylaws of the Society.

**ARTICLE IV**                      AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

The Bylaws may be amended by a simple majority of the Executive Committee.

**ARTICLE V**                      MEMBERSHIP AND DUES

- A.     **Family Membership** provides twelve months of membership for a household. The yearly dues for a family membership shall be **\$30**.
- B.     **Single Membership** provides individuals twelve months of membership. The yearly dues for a single membership shall be **\$25**.
- C.     **Honorary Membership** the honorary member shall be entitled to receive, free of charge, the monthly newsletter, all journals of the Society, and shall be entitled to one vote in Society business and to hold any office.
- D.     **Newsletter Subscription** provides for a twelve-month subscription to the newsletter. The yearly dues for a newsletter subscription shall be **\$20**.
